#### TRANSPORT

#### GPS 49°46'29.06"N, 17°31'28.512"E

Car – to the village of Stará Libavá (between Moravský Beroun and Guntramovice), go about 0,5 km uphill towards Guntramovice, on second back road go to the right (it will be signed), then stright on to the camp near small pond – the way will be signed

**Bus** – to the village of Stará Libavá, and then on foot (2 km)

Train – to the town of Moravský Beroun, and then by bus or on foot to Stará Libavá (6 km)


